HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Place in trash cans no larger than 32-gallons or in heavy duty plastic trash bags secured properly to prevent the scattering of waste due to animals or wind.

All residential waste must be placed curbside within 3 to 5 feet at the edge of the traveled portion of the roadway.

Place cans or bags curbside by 6 am on your scheduled collection day.

Non-containerized garbage, excluding bulky waste, will not be collected. No can or bag may exceed 50 lbs.

YARD WASTE

Yard Waste materials include the following:

- ☀ Grass clippings & leaves (placed in cans no larger than 32-gallons or sealed in plastic bags holding a maximum of 50 lbs.)
- ☀ Shrubs & tree limbs not to exceed 6 feet in length or 50 lbs in weight stacked parallel to the curb.
- ☀ Palm fronds

Items that are not yard waste include fencing, landscape timbers, garden hoses, planters, flower pots, and yard decorations.

PAINT PROGRAM

The SJC Solid Waste Management offers recycled paint to residents and community groups at a minimum bid price of **\$3.00 per gallon.** (Colors are limited)

WHITE GOODS

Residents may recycle these appliances curbside by scheduling a collection with their service provider:

- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Washers & Dryers
- Window Air Conditioners
- Trash Compactors
- Furnaces
- Garbage Disposals
- Stoves & Ranges
- Water Heaters
- Microwaves

RECYCLING

Place recyclable items in the recycling bins provided by your service provider by 6 am on the scheduled collection day.

Recyclable materials include the following:

- Newspapers
- Aluminum cans
- Metal food cans
- Plastic bottles marked #1 & #2 on bottom (Please rinse and remove lids)
- Glass Bottles (Clear, Green, & Brown)
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Brown paper bags
- Corrugated cardboard (no cereal boxes) cut to 2' x 3' and folded flat

DROP OFF LOCATIONS

All household garbage, recyclables, hazardous waste, and white goods may be brought to either of the St. Johns County Transfer Stations for disposal during operating hours.
