### Essential Activities

- A. For purposes of this Order and the conduct it limits, “essential activities” means and encompasses the following:
  - a. Attending religious services conducted in churches, synagogues, and houses of worship; and
  - b. Participating in recreational activities (consistent with social distancing guidelines) such as walking, biking, fishing, hunting, running, or swimming; and
  - c. Taking care of pets; and
  - d. Caring for or otherwise assisting a loved one or friend.
- B. Other essential activities may be added to this list with the approval of the State Coordinating Officer, in close coordination with the State Health Officer. The State Coordinating Officer shall maintain an online list of essential activities, as specified in this Order along with any approved additions.
- C. A social gathering in a public space is not an essential activity. Local jurisdiction shall ensure that groups of people greater than ten are not permitted to congregate in any public space.
