

### **Current Event Status**



- COVID-19 Test Collection Site at Regency Square Mall SEARS, 9501 Arlington Expressway, Jacksonville, FL 32225
  - Open to St. Johns County residents and anyone that would like to be tested.
    - Must have Identification

This site will operate from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week, for as long as supplies last. While a doctor's order and appointment are not required at this location, clients will be evaluated by a medical professional on site.

The collection facility has a tent outside and have requested that visitors wait in their cars for paperwork to be brought to them by a staff member.
  - Preforming antibody testing. It is NOT required BUT helpful to bring a copy of test results to show you have previously tested positive for the virus. It is \$255.00 total including the office visit for the antibody testing. Some insurances will cover costs. Individuals can walk-in WITHOUT an appointment but CAN NOT have symptoms.

#### Vaccine Information

- Number of first-dose vaccines given in the State of Florida (through 1/3/21): 260,655.
- Number of first-dose vaccines given to St. Johns County residents (through 1/3/21): 5,594.
- St. Johns County has established a COVID-19 Vaccine Information Hotline operational daily from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The number is 904-295-3711.
- CVS and Walgreens have begun vaccinating residents and staff of long term care facilities throughout the county.
- The current priority for vaccination efforts are frontline healthcare workers, staff/residents of long term care facilities and 65 years and older.
- An appointment-based vaccination site has been established at the Solomon Calhoun Center. Appointments are currently filled but will be made available as additional vaccines are received.
- Vaccine planning and distribution remains a key focus for the St. Johns County.

## Community Reopening

Beginning January 5, 2021 the St. Johns County Public Library System is extending hours, including the online reference service "Ask a Librarian". The Main, Ponte Vedra, and Southeast Branch libraries will be open from 10 am - 7 pm on Tuesdays and 10 am - 6 pm Wednesdays through Fridays. The Anastasia Island, Bartram Trail, and Hastings branches will be open from 10 am to 7pm on Thursdays and 10-6 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. All libraries will also be open on Saturdays from 10 am - 3 pm and remain closed on Sundays and Mondays.

#### St. Johns County/Community

- St. Johns County Mandates the Use of Face Coverings in all County Facilities
  - In an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19, a face covering mandate for all St. Johns County-owned facilities is in effect. All employees and any person working, doing business, or visiting a County facility are required to wear a face covering when social distancing of six feet or more cannot be maintained. This Emergency Order will remain in effect through the duration of the St. Johns County Emergency Proclamation 2020-1, unless otherwise rescinded by the County Administrator or his designee.
- City of St. Augustine Beach Pursuant to Resolution 20-14, the following regulations remain in effect in the City of St. Augustine Beach for so long as a state of emergency is in effect or unless otherwise modified or repealed.

Every person working, living, visiting, or doing business in the City of St. Augustine Beach shall wear a face covering in any indoor location, other than their home or residence, when not maintaining social distancing from other person(s), excluding family members or companions.
