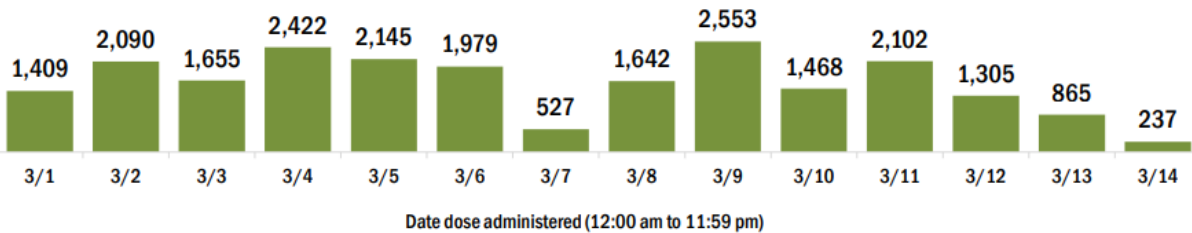

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, St. Johns County has established a Vaccine Information Hotline/call center and an appointment-based vaccination site at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The call center is operational 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, 7 days a week. The number is 904-295-3711. • To sign up for vaccine updates via text, text SJCVaccine to 888777. • St. Johns County is utilizing a pre-registration system to book COVID-19 vaccination appointments. Individuals may visit https://sjcvaccineappointment.sjcfl.us or call 904-295-3711 to register. Individuals who pre-register will receive an automated phone call from 904.295.3711 when COVID-19 vaccination appointments become available. • Executive Order 21-62 issued on March 8th expanded the priority for vaccination efforts effective March 15th. The following individuals are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccination: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Healthcare workers with direct patient contact; ○ Staff/residents of long term care facilities; ○ Individuals 60 years and older; ○ K-12 school employees 50 years of age and older; ○ Sworn law enforcement officers 50 years of age and older; ○ Firefighters 50 years of age and older; and ○ Individuals deemed extremely vulnerable by a physician and in possession of a completed Florida Department of Health COVID-19 Determination of Extreme Vulnerability form. • On March 2, 2021 a Secretarial Directive was issued by the Department of Health and Human Services Secretary prioritizing COVID-19 vaccinations to individuals who work in the pre-primary, primary and secondary schools, as well as Head Start and Early Head Start programs (including teachers, staff, and bus drivers) and those who work for licensed child care providers, including center-based and family care providers. Vaccines are available for these individuals at the Federal Vaccination Site at the Gateway Mall in Jacksonville and at local pharmacies (select CVS pharmacies, Walmarts, and all Publix pharmacies). • A Public Health Advisory has been issued by the State of Florida Department of Health requiring vaccine recipients provide proof of residency (full or part-time in the State of Florida) or proof they are present in Florida for the purpose of providing health care services involving direct contact with patients.

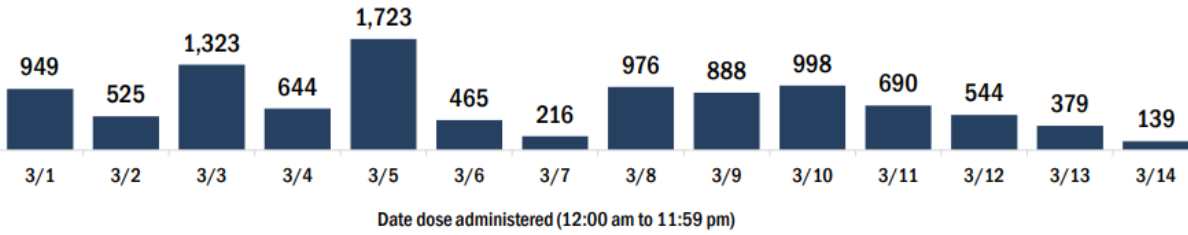
COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks



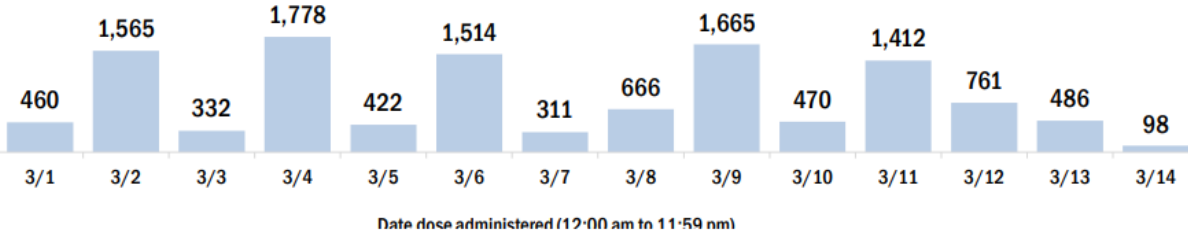

Number of persons who completed the COVID-19 vaccine series



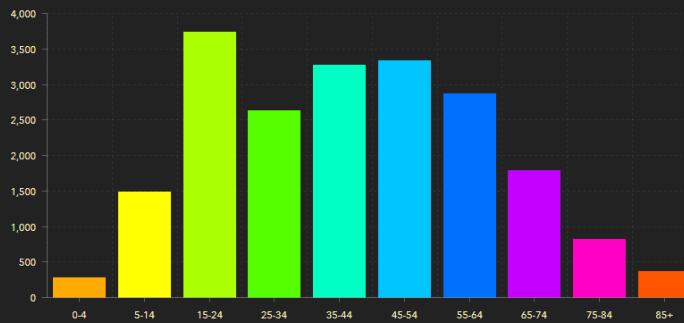

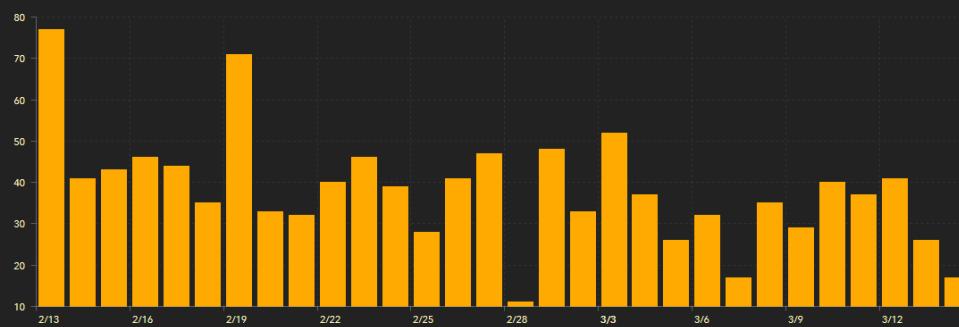

- St. Johns County - Mandates the Use of Face Coverings in all County Facilities

In an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19, a face covering mandate for all St. Johns County-owned facilities is in effect. All employees and any person working, doing business, or visiting a County facility are required to wear a face covering when social distancing of six feet or more cannot be maintained. For a full list of exemptions and enforcement policies, please visit www.sjcfl.us. This Emergency Order will remain in effect through the duration of the St. Johns County Emergency Proclamation 2020-1, unless otherwise rescinded by the County Administrator or his designee.

- City of St. Augustine Beach - Pursuant to Resolution 20-14, the following regulations remain in effect in the City of St. Augustine Beach for so long as a state of emergency is in effect or unless otherwise modified or repealed.

Every person working, living, visiting, or doing business in the City of St. Augustine Beach shall wear a face covering in any indoor location, other than their home or residence, when not maintaining social distancing from other person(s), excluding family members or companions.
