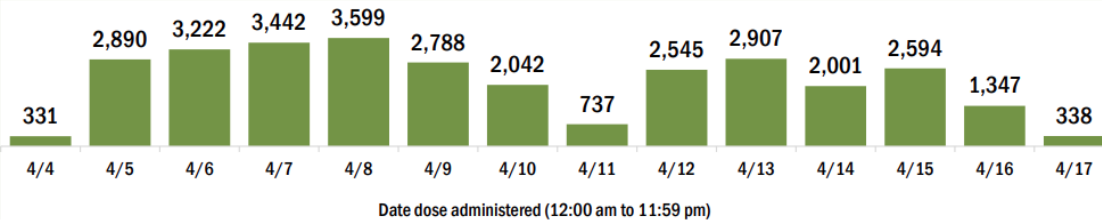

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, St. Johns County has established a Vaccine Information Hotline/call center and an appointment-based vaccination site at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The call center is operational 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday-Saturday. The number is 904-295-3711.• St. Johns County is utilizing a pre-registration system to book COVID-19 vaccination appointments. Individuals may visit https://sjcvaccineappointment.sjcfl.us or call 904-295-3711 to register. Individuals who pre-register will receive an automated phone call from 904-295-3711 or a text message to schedule a COVID-19 vaccination appointment.• No appointment will be necessary on Wednesday, April 21st between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm, to receive a COVID-19 vaccination at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center.• Executive Order 21-79 issued on March 26th expanded the priority for vaccination efforts effective March 29th. The following individuals are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccination:<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Individuals 16 years and older receiving Pfizer-BioTech;o Individuals 18 years and older receiving Moderna or Johnson and Johnson• Individuals between the ages of 16 and 18 who receive a vaccination at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center will be required to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and provide proof of age (birth certificate, passport or state-issued ID).• A Public Health Advisory has been issued by the State of Florida Department of Health requiring vaccine recipients provide proof of residency (full or part-time in the State of Florida) or proof they are present in Florida for the purpose of providing health care services involving direct contact with patients.• Vaccine availability continues to rise throughout the private sector. 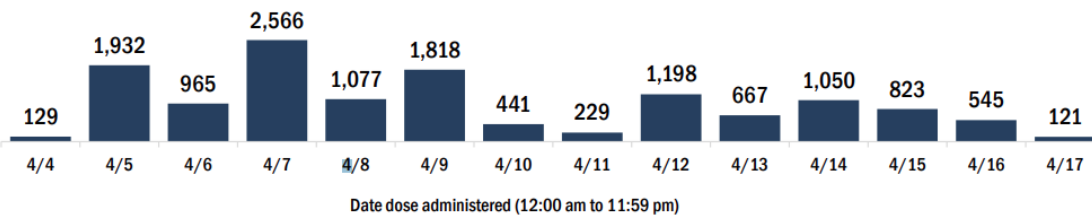

COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks

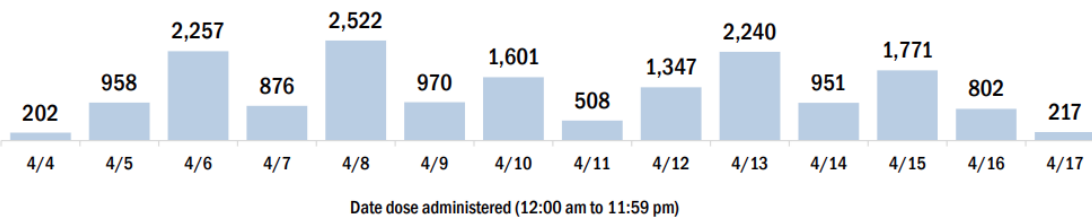


Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks

Number of persons who received their first dose of a two-dose series of the COVID-19 vaccine

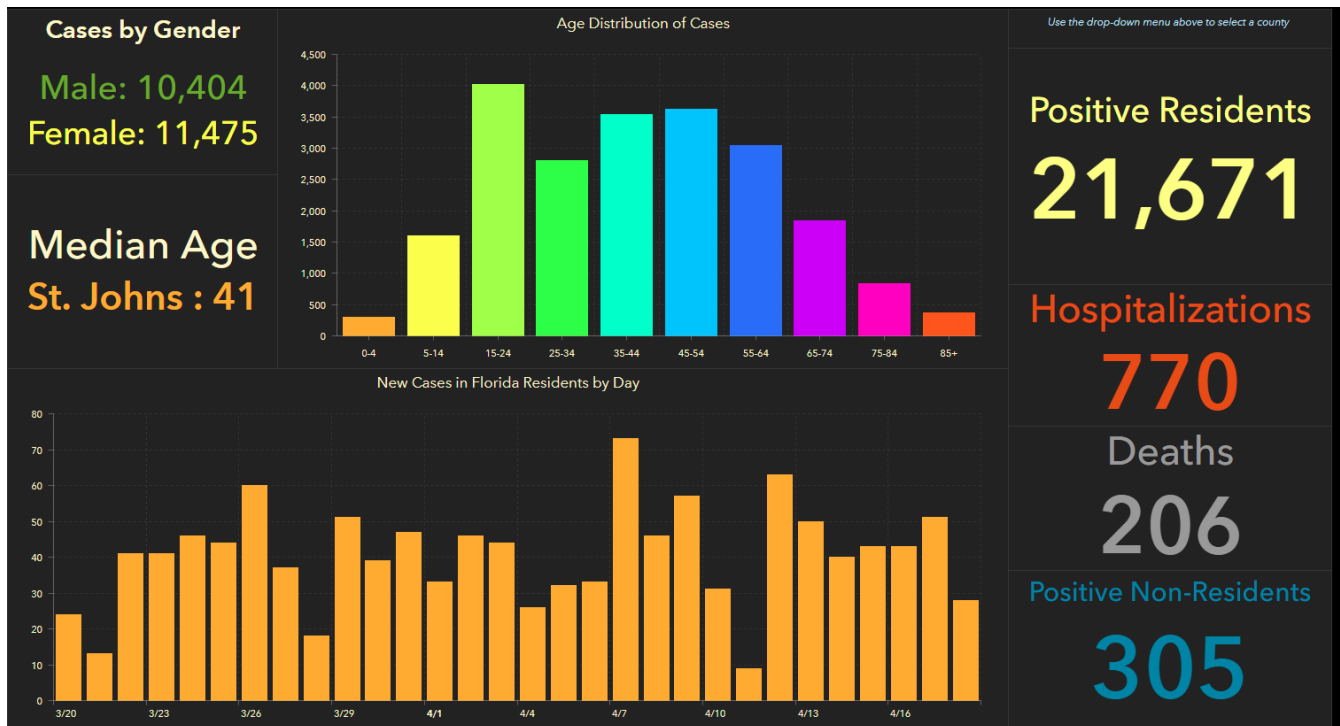


Number of persons who completed the COVID-19 vaccine series

- St. Johns County - Mandates the Use of Face Coverings in all County Facilities

In an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19, a face covering mandate for all St. Johns County-owned facilities is in effect. All employees and any person working, doing business, or visiting a County facility are required to wear a face covering when social distancing of six feet or more cannot be maintained. For a full list of exemptions and enforcement policies, please visit www.sjcfl.us. This Emergency Order will remain in effect through the duration of the St. Johns County Emergency Proclamation 2020-1, unless otherwise rescinded by the County Administrator or his designee.

- City of St. Augustine Beach - Pursuant to Resolution 20-14, the following regulations remain in effect in the City of St. Augustine Beach for so long as a state of emergency is in effect or unless otherwise modified or repealed.

Every person working, living, visiting, or doing business in the City of St. Augustine Beach shall wear a face covering in any indoor location, other than their home or residence, when not maintaining social distancing from other person(s), excluding family members or companions.
