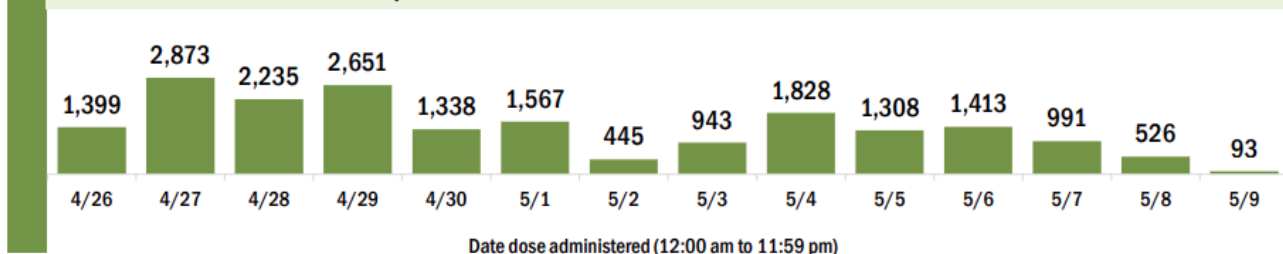
Current Vaccine Operations

- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, St. Johns County has established a Vaccine Information Hotline/Call Center and an appointment-based vaccination site at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The call center is operational 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday-Friday. The number is 904-295-3711.
 - First does vaccinations have concluded at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The site will remain open until Thursday, May 20th to administer second dose vaccinations.
 - Individuals between the ages of 16 and 18 who receive a vaccination at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center will be required to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and provide proof of age (birth certificate, passport or state-issued ID).

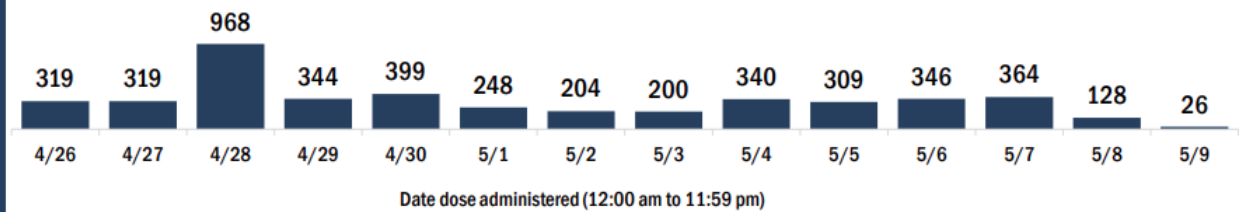
COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks



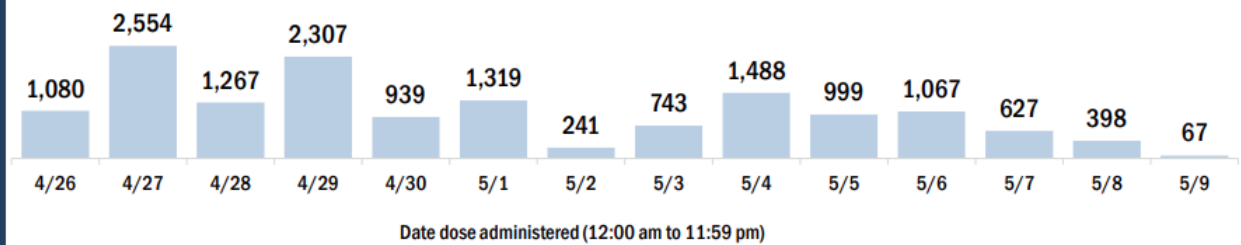

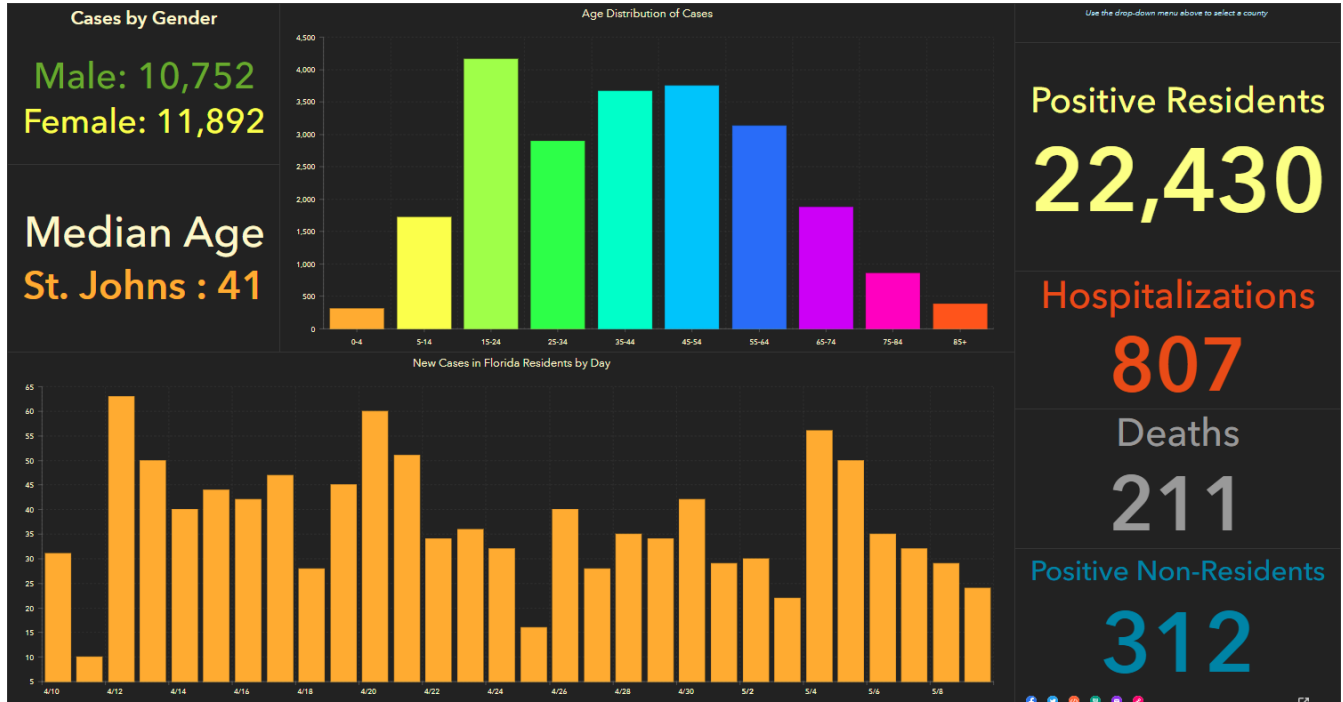
Number of persons who received their first dose of a two-dose series of the COVID-19 vaccine
