Current Vaccine Operations

- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, St. Johns County has established a Vaccine Information Hotline/Call Center and an appointment-based vaccination site at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The call center is operational 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday-Friday. The number is 904-295-3711.
- First dose vaccinations have concluded at the Solomon Calhoun Community Center. The site will remain open until Thursday, May 20th to administer second dose vaccinations.
- **The State of Florida is hosting Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccination pop-up sites at four locations in St. Johns County over the coming weeks. Each vaccination site will have 200 single-dose Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccines available for those 18 years of age and older. All vaccines will be administered on a first-come, first-served basis at the following locations:**
 - **Wednesday, May 19 – 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Hastings Branch Library, 6195 S. Main Street**
 - **Thursday, May 20 – 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Main Branch Library, 1960 N. Ponce de Leon Blvd.**
 - **Saturday, May 22 – 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Hastings Branch Library, 6195 S. Main Street**
 - **Friday, May 28 – 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Southeast Branch Library, 6670 US 1 S.**
 - **Saturday, May 29 – 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Main Branch Library, 1960 N. Ponce de Leon Blvd.**

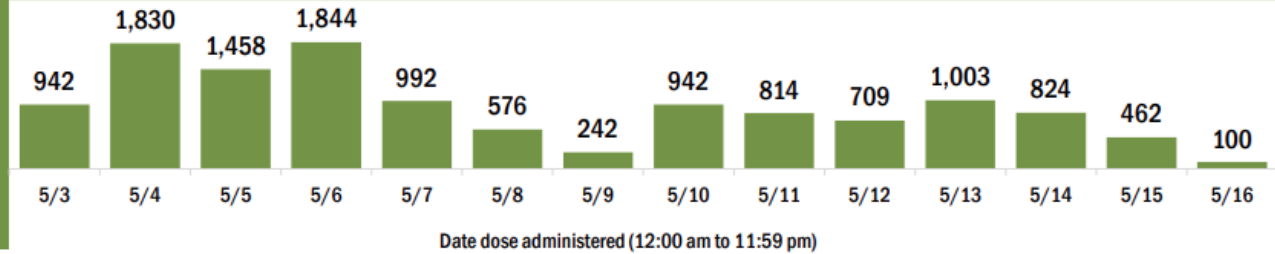

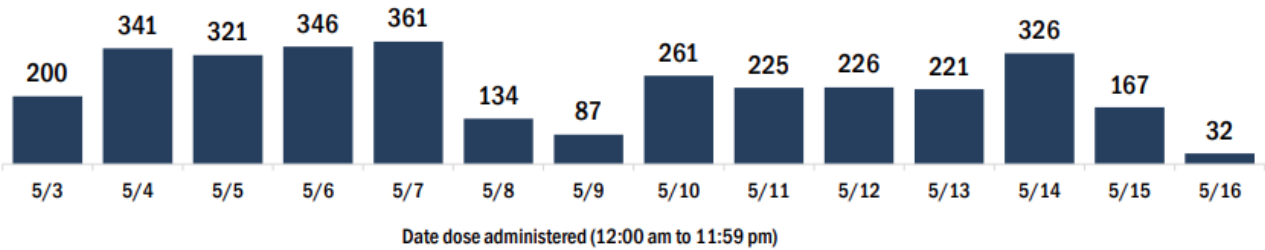
COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks



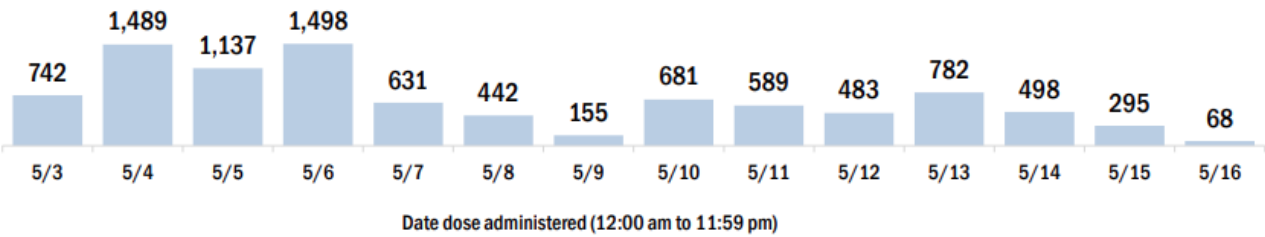

Number of persons who completed the COVID-19 vaccine series



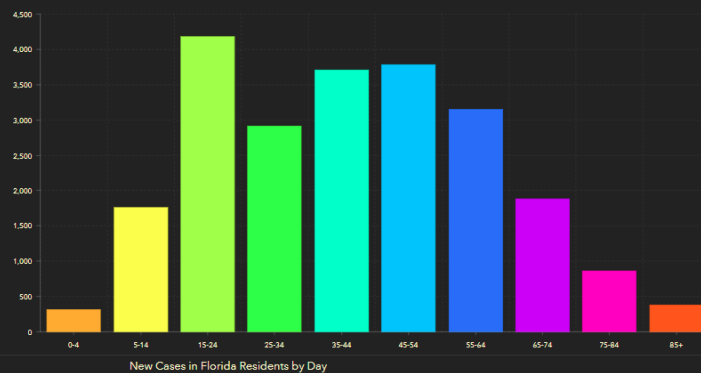

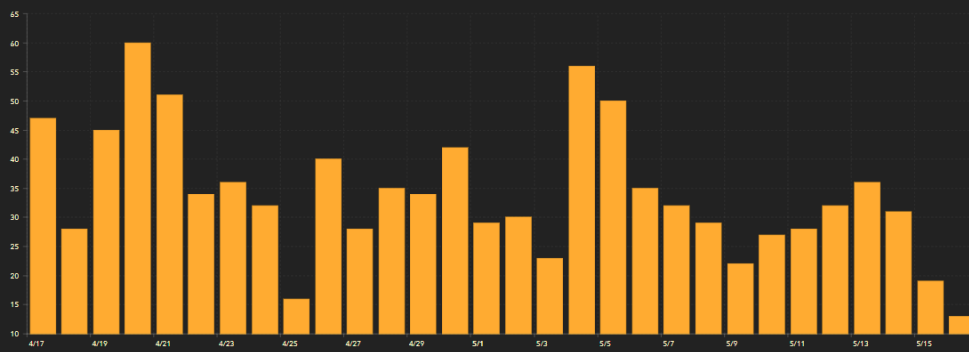
