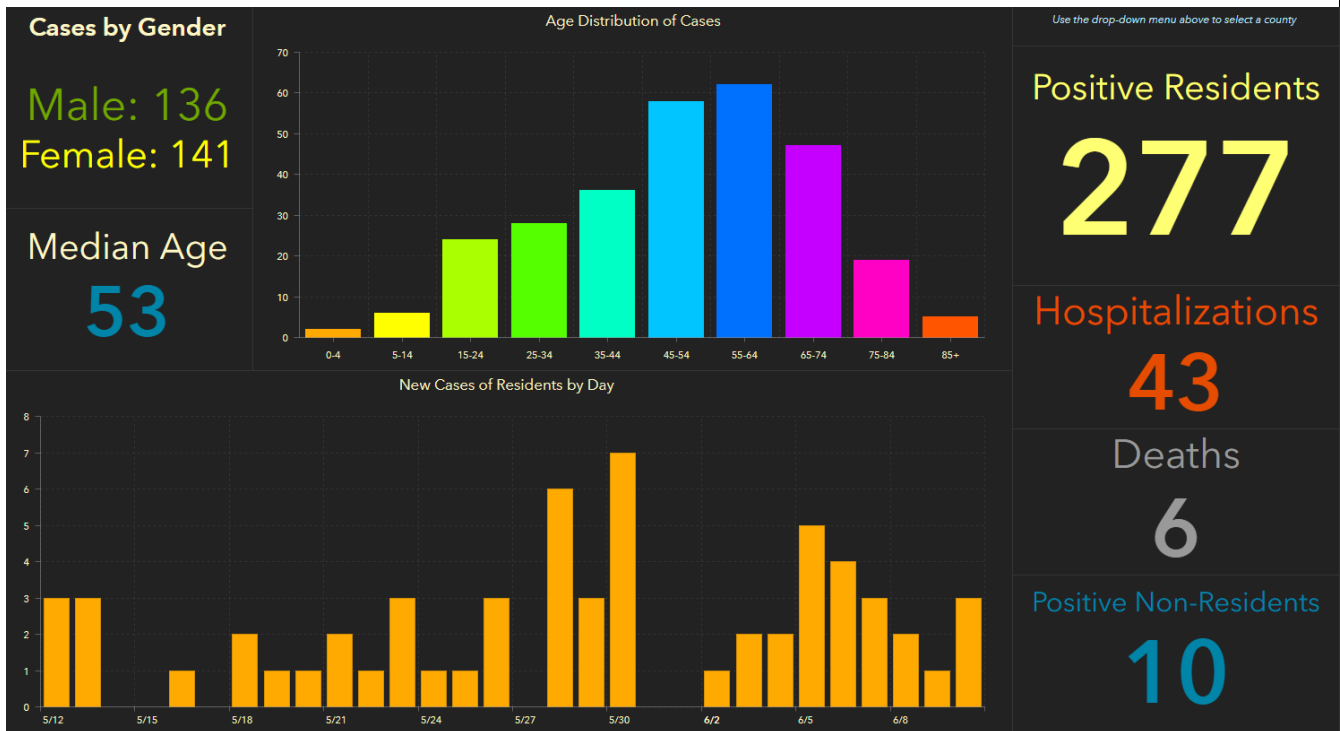

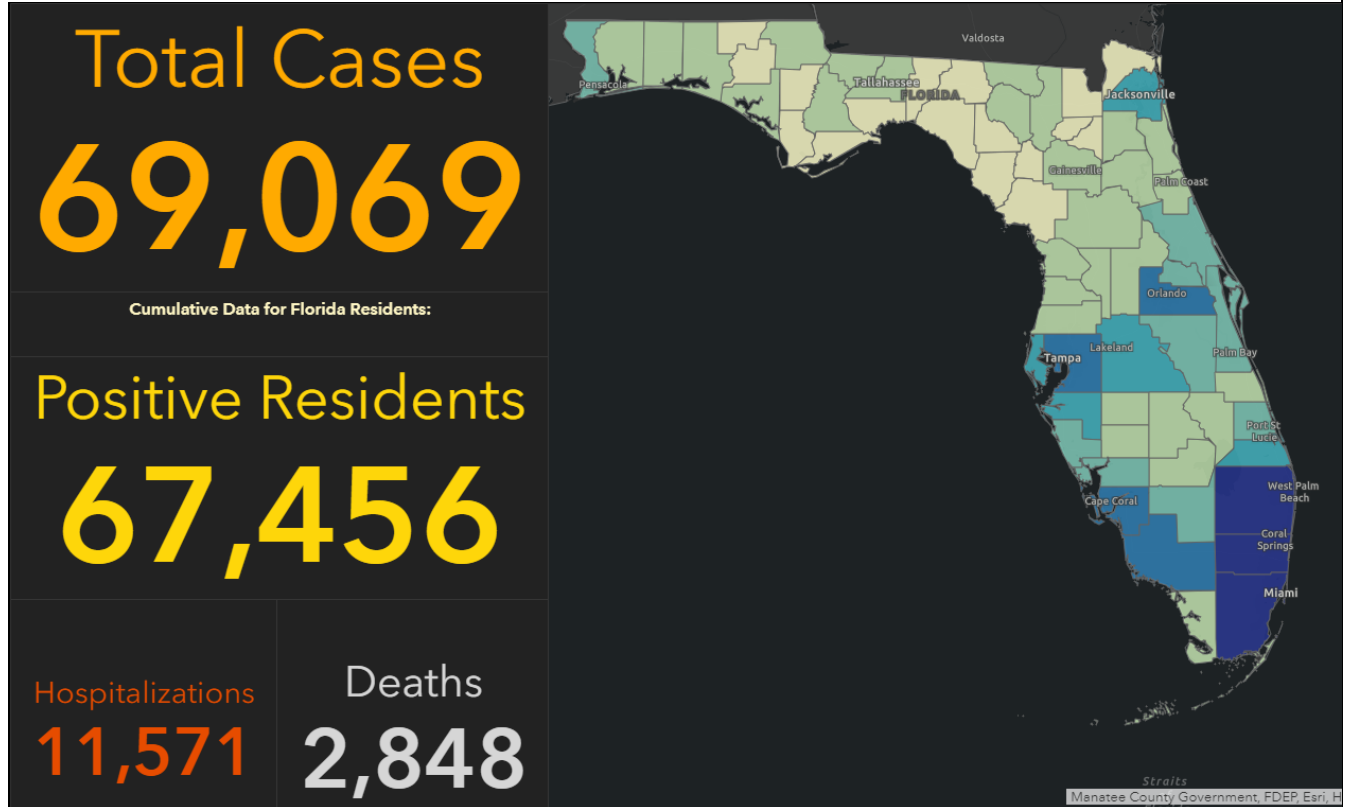

### COVID-19 Test Collection Sites

- COVID-19 Test Collection Site at TIAA Bank Field Lot J (Jacksonville Jaguars Stadium)
  - Open to St. Johns County residents and anyone that would like to be tested.
    - Must have Identification
  - This site will operate from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week, for as long as supplies last and weather permitting. While a doctor's order and appointment are not required at this location, clients will be evaluated by a medical professional on site.

  - As part of disease control investigations, DOH-SJC is collecting specimens for COVID-19 laboratory testing. As part of disease investigations, specimen collection is by appointment-only for those individuals who meet the CDC criteria for testing. For more information about COVID-19 and testing, the Florida Department of Health in St. Johns County’s COVID-19 Call Center is open seven days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and can be reached at 904-209-3250. Calls received outside of standard business hours will be redirected to a DOH-SJC Public Health Nurse.
  
- Avencia Medical - Julington Creek Branch, 1633 Race Track Rd, St Johns, FL 32259 (904) 230-6988
  - Open to the public from 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday and Sunday, as a COVID-19 collection site. Collection is being treated as an urgent care doctor’s visit and clients must bring a photo ID and insurance card. The collection facility has a tent outside and have requested that visitors wait in their cars for paperwork to be brought to them by a staff member.
  - Performing antibody testing. It is NOT required BUT helpful to bring a copy of test results to show you have previously tested positive for the virus. It is \$255.00 total including the office visit for the antibody testing. Some insurances will cover costs. Individuals can walk-in WITHOUT an appointment but CAN NOT have symptoms.

## Community Reopening

- **St. Johns County submitted and received approval of an updated Short-Term Vacation Rental Reopening Plan. The amended plan became effective June 10, 2020. The new plan addresses a variety of factors including time between rentals, cleaning and sanitization requirements, and visitors from states listed in the Governor’s executive orders. - **The Solomon Calhoun Pool, 1300 Duval Street, is expanding services and swim times beginning Monday, June 15. The pool will be available for lap swim from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and family swim from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays, and 1 to 4 p.m. on Sundays. Lap swim and family swim sessions are 45 minutes and lanes must be reserved for a lap swim session. Reservations for family swim are encouraged; however, walk-ins will be accepted based on availability. Lockers and showers are not accessible. St. Johns County leaders continue to closely follow the Governor’s executive orders and phased reopening guidelines in an effort to safely return to standard operations. - Governor Ron DeSantis Executive Order 20-139 - Phase 2 of the Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step. Plan for Florida’s Recovery.  
With appropriate social distancing and sanitization protocols, the order provides the following:
  - Restaurants may allow bar-top seating with appropriate social distancing,
  - Bars and pubs may operate at 50 percent capacity inside and full capacity outside with appropriate social distancing. Patrons may only receive service if seated,
  - Retail establishments may operate at full capacity with responsible social distancing and sanitization protocols,
  - Gyms may operate at full capacity with appropriate social distancing and frequent sanitization,
  - Entertainment businesses, including but not limited to movie theaters, concert houses, auditoriums, playhouses, bowling alleys and arcades, may operate at 50 percent capacity with appropriate social distancing and sanitization protocols,
  - Pari-mutuel facilities may submit a request to open to the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation. The request must include an endorsement from their county mayor or county administrator if there is no mayor,
  - Personal services businesses, including but not limited to tattoo parlors, acupuncture establishments, tanning salons and massage establishments may operate while adhering to guidance from the Florida Department of Health.
