St. Johns County Expands Turkey Cooking Oil Recycling Event this Holiday Season

St. Johns County is encouraging residents to go green this holiday season by recycling turkey cooking oil and more. The recycling opportunities have expanded to include used cooking oil, holiday lights, batteries, and electronic devices from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Friday, January 4 at Francis Field, 25 West Castillo Drive, and behind the St. Johns County Parks and Recreation office, 840 West 16th Street. Participants are asked to allow the used oil to cool before collecting it at home and delivering it in a safe, sealed container. The container will not be returned as the oil will be recycled off-site. Those who donate will receive free funnels for future recycling efforts.
