Growth Management Workshop to Seek Community Input

ST. AUGUSTINE, Florida, January 4, 2022 – St. Johns County has seen substantial growth over the last ten years. The 2020 Census revealed the County grew by nearly 44%, placing it among the fastest-growing counties in the United States and the second-fastest-growing County in Florida.
