St. Johns County Bridges to Open No Sooner than 12 p.m. Tuesday

St. Johns County, FL – Due to ongoing damage and safety assessments, all St. Johns County bridges will remain closed through at least 12 p.m. on Tuesday, September 12. The barrier islands sustained extensive damage and substantial high water and flooding, downed power lines, and blocked roadways remain a concern. St. Johns County officials, first responders, water and electrical service providers will continue to conduct damage and safety assessments on the barrier islands and make repairs throughout the night and morning to ensure all communities are deemed safe for re-entry. In addition, Roscoe Boulevard remains closed due to safety concerns.
