St. Johns County Cautions Beachgoers during Nor'easter

St. Johns County, FL – St. Johns County beaches are forecasted to experience unusually high surf and tides, dangerous currents, and strong winds along the coastline Saturday through Thursday as a result of nor'easter conditions. Residents and visitors are strongly encouraged to exercise extreme caution and avoid ocean swimming during this time. Some pedestrian access points may be compromised, and on-beach driving will be restricted at all access ramps beginning Sunday. Beach Services will inspect the beach throughout the week to reinstate vehicular access as soon as conditions allow. In addition, coastal flooding and erosion may occur on all St. Johns County beaches for the duration of this weather event.
