## St. Johns County Hurricane Michael Update

**St. Johns County, FL** – The St. Johns County Emergency Operations Center is actively monitoring Hurricane Michael and will continue to do so throughout the duration of the storm. The County is expected to experience strong winds, heavy rainfall, high surf, dangerous rip currents, and an increased potential for tornadoes through Thursday afternoon. At this time, St. Johns County is not under any watches or warnings; however, a coastal flood advisory is in effect.

Residents are encouraged to secure outdoor furniture and other loose items, and to continue monitoring local media for up-to-date information regarding the storm.
