St. Johns County, FL – St. Johns County Animal Control is hosting a Paws and Claws Rabies Clinic from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturday, April 22 at the St. Johns County Health and Human Services Building, 200 San Sebastian View. Residents can bring their dogs or cats to receive a one-year rabies vaccine for \$10. Microchipping will also be available for an additional \$10. Payments for services must be made in cash or check only. All pets must be on a leash or in a carrier, and at least four months of age or older. No feral or stray animals will be accepted.
