Stratton Road Solid Waste Transfer Station Closure

St. Johns County, FL – The St. Johns County Solid Waste Transfer Station at Stratton Road, 250 Stratton Road North, will be closed March 28 through 31 for repairs and refurbishing. During the repair period, solid waste typically received at this facility, including household garbage, tires, pressure treated wood, hazardous waste and commercial waste, will not be accepted.

During the Stratton Road Transfer Station closure, St. Johns County residential and commercial customers are welcome to deliver household garbage, tires, pressure treated wood, hazardous waste and commercial waste to the Tillman Ridge Transfer Station, 3005 Allen Nease Road. The Tillman Ridge Transfer Station is open to the public from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m.
