Vehicular Access Restricted on St. Johns County Beaches due to Unusually High Surf

St. Johns County, FL – All St. Johns County beaches are closed to vehicular traffic through Thursday, October 5 due to unusually high surf and tides, and periodic coastal flooding during the morning and evening hours. In addition, waves are projected to reach up to 10 feet and onshore winds will continue to be in excess of 20 mph.

Some pedestrian access points may be compromised and visitors are urged to exercise extreme caution as hazardous ocean conditions are not recommended for swimming or recreational activities. Beach Services will inspect the beach throughout the week to reinstate vehicular access as soon as conditions allow.
