

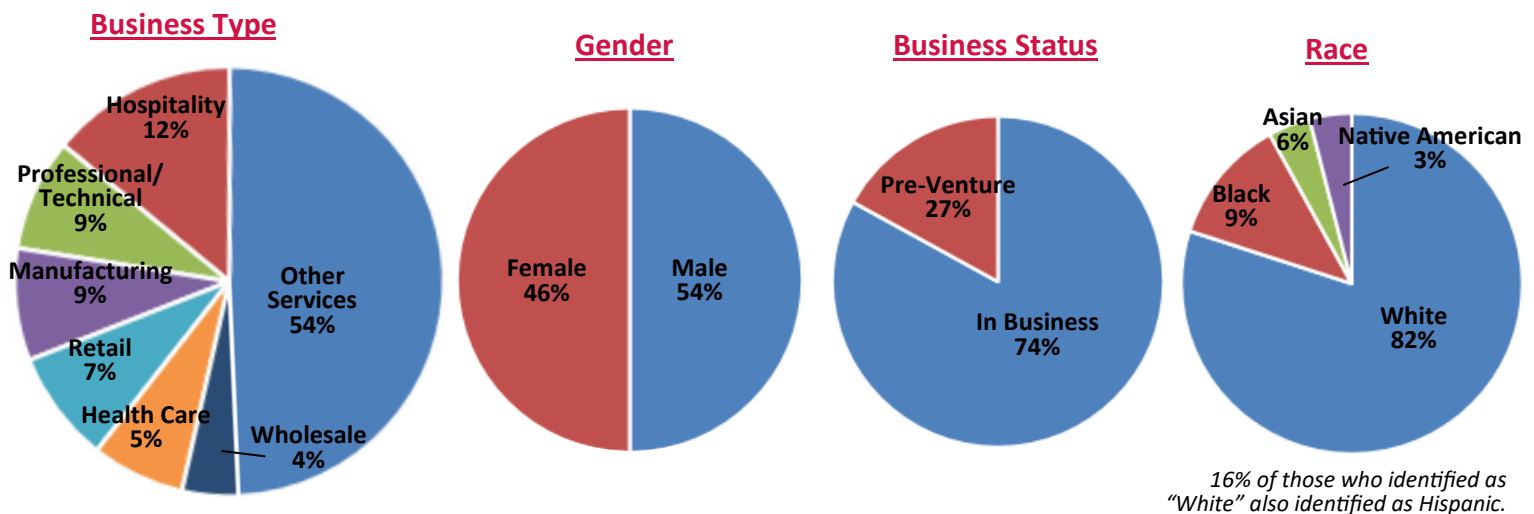

The network will also deploy its mobile assistance centers into communities for affected businesses to receive on-site assistance with disaster loans and other post-disaster challenges. Florida SBDCs also offer training on disaster preparedness, tips, and resources.
