Frontier Airlines Adds Nonstop Service from Northeast Florida Regional Airport to Philadelphia and Chicago

Celebrates with low introductory fares available only at FlyFrontier.com

St. Augustine, FL (Jan. 7, 2016) – Frontier Airlines today announced it will continue its low-fare service at Northeast Florida Regional Airport (UST) in St. Augustine, FL with the addition of two new, nonstop routes to Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) and to Chicago O’Hare International Airport (ORD). Service to Chicago will begin on April 14, 2016 while service to Philadelphia will begin on April 15, 2016.

Flights between Northeast Florida Regional Airport and Chicago will operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays while flights to Philadelphia will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Fares in these new markets will be as low as \$69 and provide savings up to 64 percent.
