

St. Augustine Amphitheatre tops amphitheater ranking

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The St. Augustine Amphitheatre sold more tickets than any amphitheater in Florida in the first half of the year, earning it the No. 11 spot in Pollstar's Mid Year Ticket Sales Top 50 Report.

The top three ticket selling spots went to Red Rocks Amphitheatre in Morrison, Colorado; BB&T Pavilion in Camden, New Jersey, and the Hollywood Bowl in Los Angeles, California. They sold about 155,000, 159,000 and 196,000 tickets, respectively.

According to the report, St. Augustine sold 75,398 tickets. Its closest Florida fellow was the No. 15 ranked Perfect Vodka Amphitheatre in West Palm Beach with 68,210 tickets sold in the past six months.

In other Pollstar rankings, the Florida Theatre in downtown Jacksonville ranked No. 51 out of the top 200 theatre venues with 80,872 tickets sold, while the Jacksonville Memorial Veterans Arena ranked No. 116 out of the top 200 arenas with 72,752 tickets sold.

Met Park ranked No. 42 of the top 50 outdoor stadium festival sites with 56,033 tickets purchased, its only Florida fellow being the Raymond James Stadium in Tampa with 52,958 tickets.
