



7 retailers opening this fall at Nocatee Town Center

Residents of Nocatee will have more options to shop and dine as soon as this Summer as seven retailers have signed leases at the Nocatee Town Center.

Four of the retailers will go into a shopping center being developed by Regency Centers that is just southeast of the Publix Supermarket in Nocatee. Artsy Abode and Gwen Berlin, both boutique clothing retailers, will take space in the center as well as Jersey Mike's Subs, GNC and Orangetheory Fitness.

Starbucks and Tijuana Flats also plan to open this summer at the Nocatee Town Center in a dual-tenant building along Crosswater Parkway.

That's in addition to South Kitchen + Sprints, which plans to open in the second half of 2017 at shopping center being developed by Skinner Bros Realty.

"The addition of restaurants and other neighborhood services is an important part of the Nocatee Master Plan," said Rick Ray, president and CEO of the PARC Group. "As the number of households continues to grow, we expect that more and more businesses will be ready to make the move to Nocatee."
