

Frontier service to Philadelphia resumes Friday

Frontier Airlines resumed its seasonal service between St. Augustine's Northeast Florida Regional Airport and Philadelphia International Airport on Friday.

The airline announced in December that the service would restart for the vacation season.

The service is scheduled to conclude Aug. 12. The flights will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays.
