

## **Two First Coast restaurants among the nation's most romantic, according to OpenTable**

OpenTable released its rankings of the most romantic restaurants in time for Valentine's Day — and two First Coast restaurants made the cut.

Collage Restaurant in Saint Augustine and Salt at The Ritz-Carlton on Amelia Island both made the online reservation platform's 2020 rankings of the nation's most romantic restaurants.

The list is based on diner reviews collected between Dec. 1, 2018, and Nov. 30, 2019. Restaurants with a minimum score and number of qualifying reviews were sorted according to the percentage of reviews, for which "romantic" was selected as a special feature.

"We craft this list every year to help diners looking for inspiration for the most popular date night of the year," Jessica Jensen, SVP of marketing at OpenTable, said in a statement. "Whether it's a special night with your significant other, a girl's night out, or your first outing with someone new, these restaurants have passed the test of setting the table for exceptional ambiance and an incredible meal."

Overall, Florida had six restaurants make this year's list. Besides the two local eateries, restaurants in Tampa, Orlando, Winter Garden and Pensacola made the list.
