St. Johns County Housing & Community Development has initiated planning for the development of the County's Program Year (PY) 2022 Annual Action Plan, which includes the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The County anticipates receiving an allocation of federal CDBG funds in the upcoming program year, which is scheduled to begin on October 1, 2022.

Soliciting public input is the first step in preparing the County's PY 2022 Action Plan. St. Johns County has scheduled four (4) Public Meetings to assess the County's housing and community development needs. The Public Meetings will be held in the North, South, East, and West corridors of the County. See the locations and respective dates and times below. Anyone wishing to comment on housing and community development needs, request information on proposed programs, or review program performance, is encouraged to attend this hearing. Housing staff will discuss issues related to the development of the Annual Action Plan and address any questions.
