The County has allocated more than \$500,000 annually, in salary and benefits for staff to carry out re-housing and homeless prevention related activities, \$62,000, which thus far, has assisted 35 households with direct rental assistance costs, and \$17,500 in direct financial assistance, used to assist 15 households, thus far, with utility assistance. Both services are funded directly from general revenue to assist households in crisis.

The County provides approximately \$2,000,000 annually to support non-profit Independent Agencies and service providers. These funds will be used to undertake community development and community service activities related to providing assistance to the homeless, disabled and underserved populations, and those having special needs.
