A YARD WASTE HOW-TO GUIDE FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION

BAG, BUNDLE OR Containerize

leaves, grass clippings, twigs, and small pieces of yard waste. Containerized yard waste should NOT exceed 32 gallons in size and 50 pounds in weight.

STACK NEATLY PARALLEL TO THE CURB

all palm fronds, branches, and shrubs. Items should NOT exceed 6 feet in length and 50 pounds in weight.

SEPARATE

garbage, recycling, and yard waste. Place curbside by 6am on the scheduled collection day.

REMEMBER:

- Do not blow leaves and yard waste into the street and storm drains that empty into nearby waterways.
- Yard waste placed in front of a vacant lot, land, or property will not be collected.
- Items that are not considered yard waste include: whole trees, land clearing debris, fencing, landscape timbers, garden hoses, planters, flowerpots, and yard decorations.
