WHAT IS THE HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN (HCP)?



Beach driving is permitted on 16.3 miles of St. Johns County shoreline, but this activity can affect protected species such as sea turtles and the Anastasia Island Beach Mouse (AIBM).

Recognizing the need to balance public access with environmental protection, the County adopted a 20-year Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) in 2006 to minimize these impacts.
