

GEOCACHING PASSPORT

RULES & INFORMATION

- Download Geocaching by Groundspeak Inc. and create a free account. The passport leads you to ten specific caches within our County parks.
- Navigate to the parks listed and search for the cache with the same name as on your passport.

Note: All cache descriptions designate that they are part of the program. Be careful, some locations will also have regular caches.

WHEN YOU LOCATE A CACHE

- Sign both the virtual log and the paper log inside the container.
- Stamp your passport with the stamp provided in the container. Take one leave one applies to items in the container, but please leave the stamp.
- The Pier is the last cache location. Once you find all ten containers and have collected all corresponding stamps on your passport, head into the Pier Gift Shop to turn in your passport and collect your prize.

Note: Only the first 100 participants will receive a prize upon completion. One prize awarded per completed passport handed in.
